Members are invited to enter work to the Annual Exhibition. Please read these rules and regulations thoroughly before completing the Entry Form on Page 3.

Exhibition Venue:

Key Dates:

We cannot accept any changes to your submissions after the closing date. Submissions received after this date will not be accepted. Please make a copy of your Entry Form for your own records.

All work must be original, i.e. not copied from any other artist/source. Works submitted for hanging must have been executed within the previous five years, and not previously exhibited in the Main Exhibition.

PAINTINGS – hung on large display boards

- You can submit up to SIX PAINTINGS (of which only TWO not for sale (NFS) are allowed).
- Watercolour paintings must be framed.
- Oil/acrylic paintings on board must be framed.
- Box canvases need not be framed but must have clean and tidy edges and not be paint splattered.
- A painting of a size where any side is over 28"/70cm is regarded as a large painting and counts as **two** paintings. Maximum size allowed on any side is 40"/1m.
- Paintings must be priced no less than £35.
- Paintings must have a label stuck firmly on the back with artist's name, title of work, medium, and price or NFS (not for sale).
 These details must exactly match your entry form.
- D-rings must be used on Framed-Pictures/Canvases and should be fitted at least 3" down from the top of the frame. Pictures must be tightly strung.



SMALL UNFRAMED PAINTINGS - displayed on special stands

• You can submit up to FOUR unframed 8"x 8" (or smaller) paintings.

- Must be protected in cellophane or plastic, with artist's name, medium, on the back.
- There must also be a price on the front to avoid too much handling.
- Paintings must be not thicker than 2cms and priced at no less than £15.

PAINTINGS – held in Browsers

- You can submit up to FOUR unframed paintings or prints of your original artwork in the browsers. These paintings should be water-based media, pastels or oil paintings on boards (no canvases).
- All browser paintings must be wrapped in cellophane and be labelled on the front with the artist's name, title, medium and price.

CARDS

- Cards may only be reproductions of your original artwork and the maximum number permitted will be 30.
- At handing-in time these must be presented in an envelope with your name on the outside, stating the total number of cards contained. If your cards have varying prices, you must include a list showing the number you are submitting at each price.
- Cards will be counted at handing in and you will be required to sign to agree the number submitted.
- Each card must be displayed in a new plastic cover. On the back of each card clear labelling with its price and the artist's name (otherwise we can't pay you!). Please price your cards in multiples of 50p (i.e. £1:00, £1:50, £2:00, £2:50, etc).

SCULPTURES

- Sculptures should be of a moderate size as space for displaying them is limited.
- All sculptures should be labelled with a stuck-on label or tied on tag displaying the artist's name, medium used and price.
- Unsold sculptures will be collected from a designated table at the end of the exhibition.

COLLECTION OF UNSOLD ARTWORKS

Unsold artworks should be collected between 5.00pm and 5.30pm on Sunday 4th August. If you are unable to collect your work, please arrange for someone to collect it on your behalf. The exhibition will close at 4.00pm to give the committee and invited helpers time to take down the artwork ready for collection. For safety, only those delegated to help will be allowed in the hall during this period.

HANGING/DISPLAY FEES

There is a sliding scale of hanging/display fees based on the artwork size and type (see Entry Form for details). Please ensure you fill in the correct fees and calculate the correct total to pay at time of submitting your Entry Form.

COMMISSION

Commission is 20% on all picture and sculpture sales. Commission on card sales is 10%.

PAYMENTS TO MEMBERS
